ROLE:

Volunteering within the session

Making Cakes

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

Make and serve coffee, tea and cakes for adults attending the group.

To be available either from 9:30-11am or 10:45-12:15 on a rostered basis (usually once a month).

Engage in conversation with the adults in the group and to help with the smooth running of the group.

If on the 9:30-11am session - help with setting up the session (at 9:30 am on a Friday morning), this involves getting out small and large toys, setting up tables and chairs, and kitchen equipment.

If on the 10:45-12:15 session -Help with clearing/tidying up at the end of the session.

To make cakes for the session on a rostered basis (usually once a month).

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE:

The energy to lift and shift tables!

Ability to make a good cup of tea/coffee (training given if required!) and to serve with a smile.

A welcoming smile and an ability to work as part of a team.

Ability to make cake/biscuits or muffins!
