

PRAYER MINISTRY TEAM

MINISTRY VISION/PURPOSE:

To journey with members of the congregation in prayer, being open to the Holy Spirit to encounter God's love, guidance, healing power and blessings.

ROLE:

Two members of the prayer team pray together for people who come for prayer at the end of the Sunday services.

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

To be available for 1-2 services per month. Wear a name badge.

Arrive at church 20 minutes before the start of a service to be prepared, pray for each other and the service.

To proceed to the designated prayer location during the last song/hymn, just before the end of the service to be ready for those who come for prayer.

To listen carefully and empathetically, being sensitive to the needs of those who come for prayer.

To maintain utmost confidentiality and reassurance so people feel supported and encouraged.

To be sensitive to the Holy Spirit with an understanding of scripture to pray with confidence in an appropriate and gracious manner.

To continue to hold people in private prayer for at least 2 weeks following.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE:

Empathy, a good listener, trusted to keep a confidence. To be sensitive to the Holy Spirit with an understanding of scripture to pray with confidence in an appropriate and gracious manner.

Reliability

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED:

Basic Awareness safeguarding training is required. A prayer rota and guidance notes are provided. New team members are always placed with an experienced team member for on-the-job training and support.
