

SOUND TEAM



MINISTRY VISION/PURPOSE: To allow the congregation to hear the service easily: speech, musicians and other audio sources as required.

ROLE: Sound technician at one of the Sunday or midweek services in the church or the hall.

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES: Being part of the sound team for a service just once or twice a month. We are flexible in terms of availability and can work around your schedule and commitments in our app-based scheduling software (Planning Centre).

Before the start of the service you will power up the sound desk and amps and be on hand to help set up microphones and equipment for musicians. You will undertake a sound check and then adjust sound levels as needed to produce a round and cohesive sound.

During the service you will listen to all the sound aspects in the service and make small adjustments to the sound levels as needed. You will mute and un-mute channels on the desk as required, monitoring the sound throughout the service.

At the end of the service, putting all equipment away tidily and securely, helping the music team pack down their equipment ready for the next service.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE: Reliability, patience and a calm disposition, ability to be part of a team, with flexibility to cover holidays, illnesses and extra services as needed. Good hearing is important as is an interest in musicality.

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED: Full training and support will be given for as long as it is needed. For the first few services you would work alongside a current member of the team; this would allow you to familiarise yourself with the role and its duties and to ask any questions you may have along the way. A folder of information/help sheets is always available by the sound desk. You will never be expected to run the system until you are completely confident and comfortable with it all.
