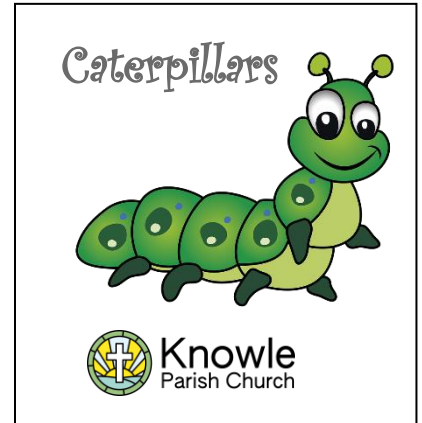
Caterpillars runs during term time on a Monday morning from 12-1.15pm in the Guild House.

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

Helping with setting up the session at 11.15am on a Monday morning, this involves getting out toys, moving chairs and tables and setting up craft and play activities.

Make and serve coffee and tea for adults attending the group. Make and serve water and fruit for children to have with their lunch. To be available from 11.15 on a rostered basis (usually once a month).

Helping with the set up and tidy-up of the toys and craft, engaging in conversation with the adults and children in the group and to help with the smooth running of the group.

The energy to lift and shift tables!

Ability to make a good cup of tea/coffee (training given if required!) and to serve with a smile.

A welcoming smile and an ability to work as part of a team.

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED:

For all roles:

Basic online Safeguarding training.

On the job training provided by a member of the Caterpillars team.

Team gatherings at the beginning of the Autumn term and through the year.
