We want to be the go-to place of nurture, support and encouragement for under 5s and their carers in Knowle, offering a warm, welcome space to belong, have fun and connect with one another and God.



ROLE:

Dads & Toddlers Team Member at our sessions that run on the 2nd Saturday of the month in St John's Hall, 10.00 am – 11.30 am.

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

Arrive 30 mins early at St John's Hall at 9.30 am to help the team set up play and craft activities and to gather together to pray before session commences.

Sessions begin at 10.00 am and team roles include:

- Welcome and register dads and their children upon arrival
- Prepare and serve hot and cold drinks, snacks and bacon baps (food and drink materials supplied)
- Mingle and engage with dads during main activity sessions in the hall – key aspiration here is to have good interaction and conversations
- Opportunity to lead story times for children and dads
- Promote other events within the Church community
- Clear away / tidy up kitchen
- Help with clearing away in hall after session has finished (typically c. 20 mins, from 11.30 am)

Hopes: That through the group we continue to adhere faithfully to the aims of Connect, namely to serve people as Jesus would, draw people into a Jesus centred community and connect people with Jesus.
