St John's Sparkhill, April 2024

- **Discipleship**: continued growth in Christlikeness for us all, encouraged by a culture of transformation embodied in culturally appropriate means of engagement with one another.
- Growing interculturality. We are a collection of many different minorities and want to celebrate this intentionally and well.
- **Community**: continued embedding of the Church within our context (eg. through the Gaza humanitarian fundraiser on 27 April), meaning that Muslim neighbours experience St John's as a place which is *for* them.
- **Evangelism**: increasing 'Nicodemus' moments where we can have conversations about the deep things of the Spirit with local people; appropriate ways of building relationships with these neighbours and friends.
- Thank God for the increasing numbers of people who come into the life of St John's through the foodbank (and, indeed, for our growing numbers over all: up to a third of our congregation is under 18 too). Pray that many other doors will be opened into the life of the Church.
- **Service**: Continued changes at Narthex, and our increasing 'reach' across the city and region. We don't want to build an empire; we do want to model a better way of supporting resilient local communities and helping them strengthen and grow.
