About KPC and the Role

Knowle Parish Church (KPC) is a large Church in a semi-rural location in the south of Solihull, West Midlands in the Diocese of Birmingham. We have a broad Bible based evangelical tradition and offer a diverse range of four Sunday Services covering a breadth of worship styles.

The Organist and Choir Leader will be managed by, and work collaboratively with, the Worship Minister to deliver the weekly Sunday 11.15am service in the main church. This service is a traditional liturgical service involving a robed choir and our well-maintained Walter James Bird & Son Organ. The service music is led by the Organist and Choir Leader and most services feature an anthem sung by the choir, hymns and voluntaries. There is a Holy Communion service once a month and on the other weeks the service follows the structure of the Common Worship Morning Prayer. This service is attended by between 65 – 80 people and is a valued part of the worship expression at KPC.

There are 20 people in our choir at present. They are a group who support, and enjoy fellowship with, each other. The choir has recently been renamed and rebranded as St John's Choir and is open to all members of the local community who would like to come and sing in a church setting. The choir has a clear missional element to its function that brings fun, fellowship and the gospel to the local community and beyond. We are keen to appoint a permanent person in this role who would work collaboratively with our Worship Minister to develop the choir, their skills and to grow the choir's membership. They would be concerned not only with the musical abilities of the choir but would also take on a pastoral role, as this post is for someone with a vocation for this kind of work. The appointed Organist and Choir Leader would benefit from having a permanent contract of employment with the church which would include paid holiday and sick pay and they would become part of a very friendly, supportive and hard-working staff team in a vibrant church at the heart of the local community.

The Organist and Choir Leader will be paid for 6 hours per week but there will be flexibility in hours worked: around major Festivals and the lead up to them, more hours per week will be worked and correspondingly fewer in 'ordinary' weeks

We would consider applications from people willing to job share the role or people willing to take on either one of the organist and choir director roles but not the other, so do contact us if you would be interested in this.

Key responsibilities

- Directing the choir at the weekly 11.15am Sunday service and other principal festivals as agreed throughout the year and playing the organ at some of these services
- Working with the clergy on the choice of hymns for these services
- Selecting an anthem for the choir to sing at the services



- Leading a weekly choir practice (1.5 hours on a Thursday evening)
- Nurturing, encouraging and developing the skills of the choir members and praying for and pastoring them in their faith
- Drawing in and recruiting new members to the choir and praying for the missional focus of the choir
- Playing the organ and leading the choir (when required) for weddings and funerals in the church as availability permits (for which an agreed additional fee would be paid)

Terms

An annual salary of £5,250.

The post is subject to a 6 month probationary period. The Organist and Choir Leader is entitled to 25 days holiday per year (pro rata, this equals 30 hours holiday). This appointment is subject to acceptable pre-appointment checks, including a satisfactory enhanced DBS check.
