**Outside Giving 2024** In 2024 KPC gave nearly £40,000 to our 3 regional churches and UK and International mission projects. We also gave £27,000 to the Diocese (above our ministry costs) to support mission work throughout the Diocese.

#### **Retiring Collections at Christmas services**

This year the retiring collections from last Sunday's Carol Services and our other Christmas services will be divided between The Family Care Trust and International Needs' Kenya Street Youth project.

The Family Care Trust is a Solihull charity, offering professional care and support services to individuals with mental health conditions, learning disabilities, and physical disabilities. It aims to empower these individuals to live their lives with dignity, choice, and independence through a variety of services, including work-based learning at Newlands Bishop Farm, the Blanning Dementia Day Centre and supported living sites. International Needs' Kenya Street Youth project: in Kenya's capital city Nairobi, there are around 60,000 homeless children and young people, over 70% of whom are boys and young men. International Needs works to support and empower them and aid their reintegration back to their families and into society. They are looking to build a residential Leadership and Talent Centre, to be a place of safety for 25 boys/young men at a time.
